For the second year, the Bananas have come in 2nd in the country in attendance, according to Ballpark Digest.

The regular season brought in 108,498 fans. Almost 10,000 more than the third place

team - despite have ten fewer home games.

The Bananas also lead the Coastal Plain League in attendance for the second year in a row and <u>ranked 73rd</u> out of all collegiate, independent, and Minor League baseball teams.

The Bananas welcomed 17,494 more fans than they did in 2017. They broke the league attendance record they set in 2016 (91,004). The team also sold out 8 more games than they did in 2016.
